1.1 General Safety Instructions

WARNING

To reduce the risk of burns, fire, electrical shock, or injury:


- Use the platform for its intended use only, according to the instructions.
- Always turn all switches off and unplug the platform from the electrical outlet before hardware installation, maintenance, servicing, or repairs. Hazardous voltages may still be present in the power supply even several minutes after it has been turned off.
- Indoor use only do not store or use the product outdoors.
- Keep the platform away from heat sources, high humidity, water, and other liquids. Do not store in a very cold space where condensation may occur.
- Keep all component guards and shields in place and do not touch the internal components when the platform is powered on.

2.1 Cockpit Compatibility

The Next Level Racing[®] Motion Plus Platform is designed specifically for the Next Level Racing[®] GTtrack, Next Level Racing[®] GTseat Add-On (combined with a compatible Wheel Stand to make full Cockpit), Next Level Racing[®] F-GT Elite and Next Level Racing[®] GT Elite cockpits, but it can be adapted to other cockpits. For certain brands of cockpits, we provide adapter plates - for other cockpits, custom assembly might be required.

Achievable pitch value depends on the distance between the two motion units or between the motion unit and the pivot bar.



Once the motion platform is securely mounted, the distance between motion units has to be measured and entered as a configuration parameter in the platform manager.



For single motion unit installation, for the best possible immersion, we recommend to install the Next Level Racing[®] Motion Plus Platform at the front and the pivot bar at the rear.



Next Level Racing[®] F-GT Elite






3.2 Pivot Bar Assembly

Pivot bar is used to stabilize the cockpit in single motion unit installation. It can be installed at the front or at the rear, depending on your preferences. This component comes in 3 pieces that need to be assembled together before the pivot bar can be installed to the cockpit.




3.3 Foot Assembly and Installation


The foot is used to stabilize the motion platform operation during extreme roll angles. After all pieces are assembled together, the foot is attached directly to the motion unit.













3.4 Motion Platform Installation Options

For single motion unit configuration, it is recommended to install **the motion unit at the front** of the cockpit and **the pivot bar at the rear**. Power socket, USB socket and power switch must always point forward (toward the display/TV). Reversed (180°) motion platform installation is not supported.






3.5 Installation in F-GT Elite and GT Elite






Installation of the Next Level Racing[®] Motion Plus Platform in Next Level Racing[®] F-GT Elite and Next Level Racing[®] GT-Elite cockpits is very similar. The only difference is the height at which the brackets are installed to the motion unit. Different holes are used for different cockpits. Notch in the bracket indicates "front".




Install the motion unit.





Install the pivot bar.








Install the motion unit.




Install the pivot bar.






Dual Motion Units Configuration





Motion Plus Platform + Motion Platform V3

Next Level Racing[®] Motion Plus Platform and Next Level Racing[®] Motion Platform V3 can work together as a single motion platform. It is possible to combine 1x or 2x Next Level Racing[®] Motion Plus Platform with Next Level Racing[®] Motion Platform V3.


- 1. If the Next Level Racing[®] Motion Plus Platform is installed at the **front** Next Level Racing[®] Motion Platform V3 can be installed at its default location.
- If the Next Level Racing[®] Motion Plus Platform is installed at the rear Next Level Racing[®] GTultimate adapters should be used to attach Next Level Racing[®] Motion Platform V3 to the cockpit.
- 3. If the 2x Next Level Racing[®] Motion Plus Platform are installed Next Level Racing[®] GTultimate adapters should be used to attach Next Level Racing[®] Motion Platform V3 to the cockpit.

For case no. 1, follow Next Level Racing[®] F-GT Elite and Next Level Racing[®] GT Elite user manual to install Next Level Racing[®] Motion Platform V3 at its default location. For case no. 2 and 3, check the following instructions.


3.6 Installation in GTtrack and GTseat Add-On

Installation in Next Level Racing[®] GTtrack cockpit does not require any additional brackets to be attached to the motion unit. The motion platform is bolted directly to the cockpit's frame.






Motion Unit at the Front

Install the motion unit.




Install the pivot bar.






Motion Unit at the Rear

Install the motion unit.





Dual Motion Units Configuration

Next Level Racing[®] GTtrack Cockpit supports dual motion units configuration. Refer to previous sections to see how to install the motion units at the front and at the rear.



GTseat Add-On


In order to install the Next Level Racing[®] Motion Plus Platform to the Next Level Racing[®] GTseat Add-On, a compatible wheel stand is required. Once you combine the Next Level Racing[®] GTseat Add-On with the appropriate Wheel Stand to complete full Cockpit, please refer to the Next Level Racing[®] GTtrack installations steps.



3.7 Installation using 3rd party hardware

If the motion unit is installed using 3rd party hardware, it is crucial to select the correct screw lengths based on the thickness of the brackets and the maximum allowable depth. The depth defines how much the screw can go inside the motion unit housing.

- Side wall holes the maximum depth is 12 mm.
- Top side holes the maximum depth is 22 mm.




WARNING

Use of screws that go deeper into the motion unit housing than then specified limit may cause damage to the unit. Such damage is not covered by the standard warranty.

3.8 Ferrite Core Installation

Once you choose which power cable will be used in your setup, install the attached ferrite core. Make sure to place the core on the power cable as close to the motion platform as possible.



3.9 Connecting to PC and Software Installation

Once the motion platform is securely installed::

- 1. Plug in the power cord and turn on the motion unit. As soon as it is on, the platform will perform the initial position calibration, moving the cockpit. After a few seconds, the green light will come on, indicating that the unit is ready to use.
- Connect the platform directly to PC USB port. Using a USB hub is not recommended. The operating system will automatically install the necessary drivers. Be sure to check that the USB and power cords have enough clearance and do not interfere in the operating range of the platform to prevent damaging cords and cables.
- 3. Visit **www.nextlevelracing.com/support-downloads** to download and install the software, providing your product's serial number.



4 Device Configuration

When the Next Level Racing[®] Motion Plus Platform is connected to PC, the platform manager will detect if there is a new firmware available for the device and advise you to install it. Please follow on screen instructions and install the firmware.

Once the firmware is installed, configuration process has to be performed. There should be an issue displayed in **Action Center** that reminds you about it. Each Next Level Racing[®] Motion Plus Platform requires two parameters to operate correctly:

- 1. Motion unit location under cockpit front or rear
- 2. Distance between the motion units or the between motion unit and the pivot bar


For dual motion units configuration, one unit has to be configured as **front** and another as **rear**. Both units must have the same value for distance parameter entered in configuration.

To access configuration at any time, go to Tools and Diagnostic (1), Devices (2).





In new window select if the motion unit acts as front or rear unit (4) and enter the distance between motion units (5).





5 Maintenance

To reduce the risk of fire, keep the platform dust-free. To clean the unit, use a soft, dry cloth. Do not use solvents or cleaners that may corrode or otherwise damage aluminum, steel, or plastic parts of the platform.

No other maintenance is required.
